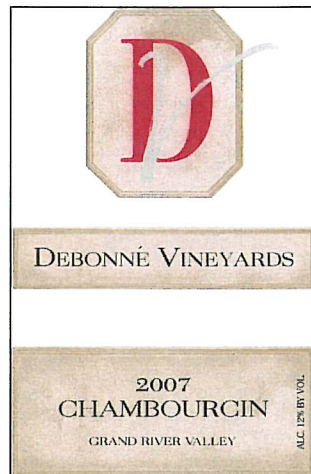


2007 Chambourcin
